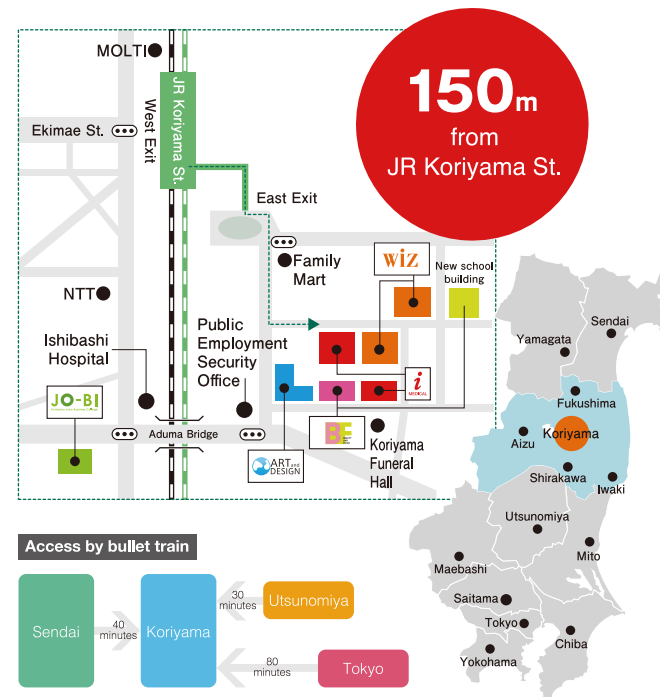

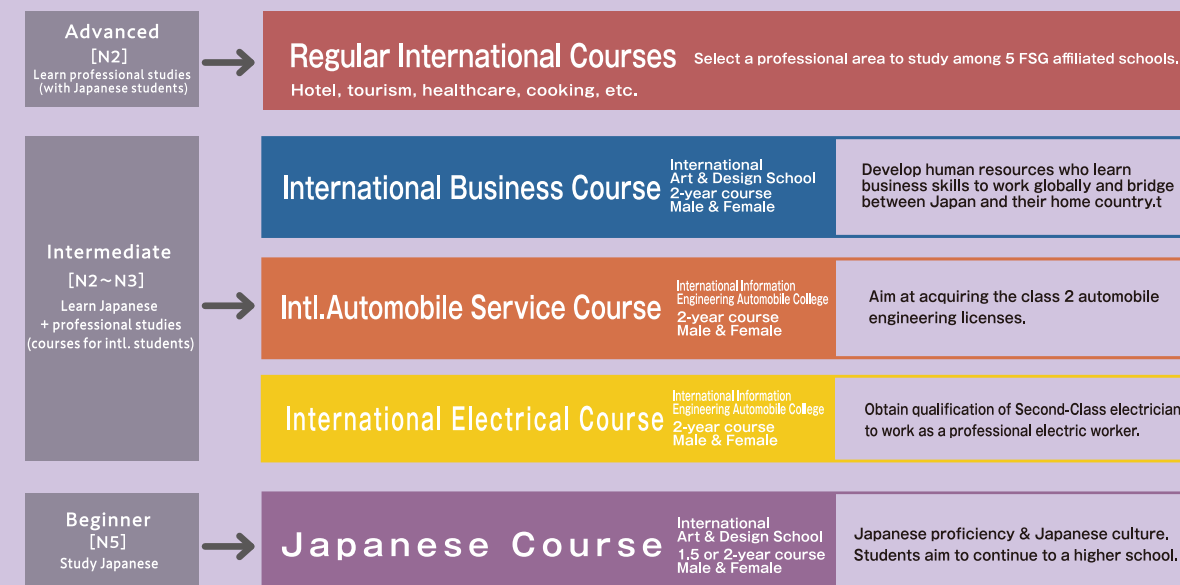

## Residence

We provide information on a variety of apartments and condominiums for rent. Individual apartments without a guarantor requirement are also available.

**Rent** Single room:28,000jpy  
Double room:20,000jpy  
All apartments have a kitchen, bathroom, and toilet.

## Part-time Jobs for FSG International Students

FSG introduces part-time jobs to support your life, balancing study and work. Many types of part-time jobs are offered, such as manufacturing in a factory and servicing in a restaurant.

Wage is 850 - 1,150 yen per hour.  
Income reaches 90,000 - 120,000 yen per month.

You can work longer during the spring, summer and winter vacation and save money for school and living expenses. Jobs can be selected depending on your Japanese level.  
\* In Japan, international students are allowed to work up to 28 hours a week (up to 8 hours a day during a long vacation).



Notice

With the introduction of the Social Security and Tax Number System (the My Number System) in Japan in October 2015, the personal identification number is to be given to each of international students as well. Total of your working hours and income is identified and reported using this number. FSG aligns with the students' employers such that the students can be engaged in their jobs within the time frame allowed by law. We also provide a financial plan designed for the individual student in order to support the students' life on the financial front.
