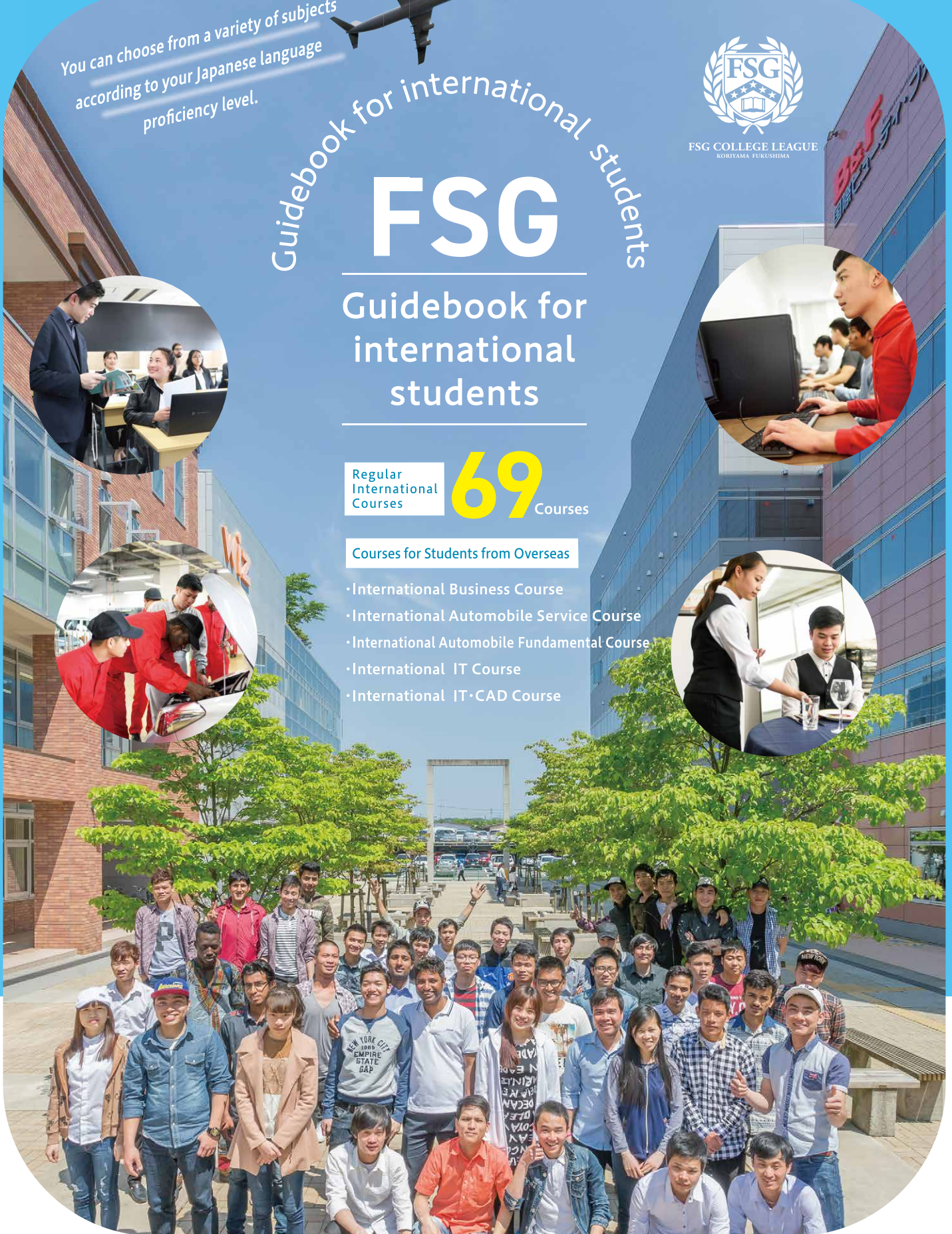

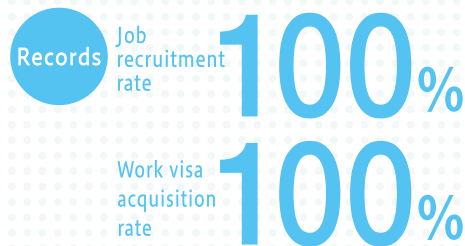

Admission Qualification

Those who have completed or are expected to complete standard school education for 12 years or more and meet any of the following conditions:

- ① Those who possess Japanese language proficiency at or above Japanese Language Proficiency Test N2 (Level 2)
- ② Those who have scored over 200 points in Japanese language subjects (Reading Comprehension, Listening Comprehension, and Listening-reading Comprehension) in the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU).
- ③ Those who have received one year or more of education at a Japanese language education institution in Japan.
- ④ Those who have received one year or more of education at a school specified in Article 1 of the School Education Act of Japan.

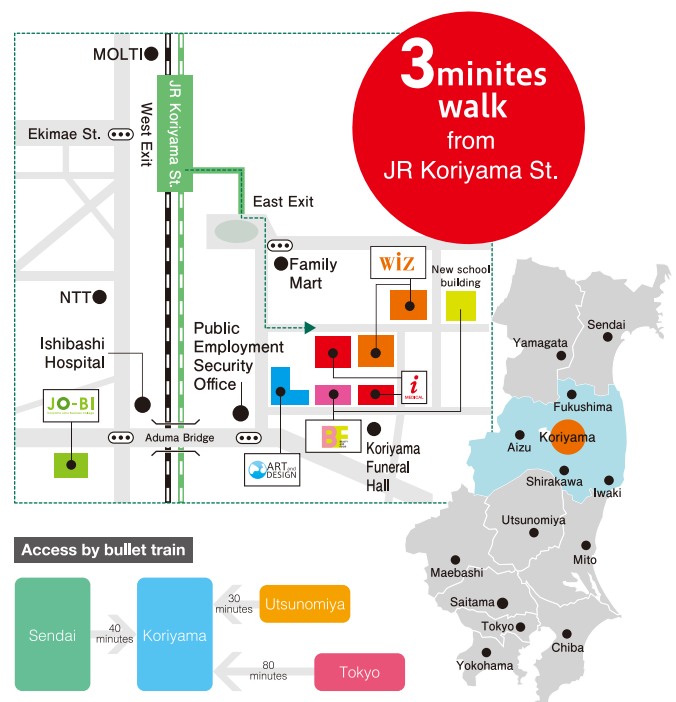
